Gal 4:15 Where is then the blessedness ye spake of? for I bear you record, that, if *it had been* possible, ye would have plucked out your own eyes, and have given them to me.

Lloyd-Jones – "The question confronting us is this: What was the cause of the change? What had happened to them? And the answer is perfectly simple, and can be put in one phrase – it was all entirely due to false teaching."

The Galatians had forfeited their blessedness by heeding a false gospel, one that could not provide a sure salvation. Paul had preached grace to them and yet they were told that they must return to the law for their justification.
